All correspondence to WIPO should kindly be sent exclusively via email, with no paper copy, to wipo.mail@wipo.int until further notice. This will enable correspondence to be dealt with in a timely manner by staff working remotely, in accordance with WIPO's business continuity protocols.

All outward official circulars and notifications from WIPO will likewise be transmitted by email in order to ensure their reliable delivery, with no paper hard copies dispatched to postal addresses.

Intellectual Property Offices and users of WIPO's Global IP Services have been notified separately with specific advice on communications with the PCT, Madrid and Hague registries.
