In July 2023, the Federal Court of Appeal rejected the Federal Court's proposed framework for assessing eligibility of computer-implemented inventions and sent Benjamin Moore's patent application back to CIPO for redetermination of patentability. In doing so, the FCA considered not only Canadian case law relating to the definition of "invention," but also U.S. and Australian jurisprudence.
